Notes for Match Officials: -

Each referee is requested to confirm acceptance, or otherwise, of their appointment(s) to the SFA Disciplinary and Referee Department by e-mail. If, after having confirmed acceptance, it is necessary to withdraw from an appointment, contact should initially be made by telephone with the SFA Disciplinary and Referee Department and thereafter confirmed by e-mail.

White and yellow copies of misconduct report forms, and other relevant correspondence arising from matches, should be sent to the SFA Disciplinary and Referee Department, Hampden Park, Glasgow, G42 9AY.

The dates of birth of players being reported for misconduct to the Scottish Football Association should be denoted on the misconduct report form by referees, where the information is provided on teamlines.

Referees are requested to telephone the following number – 0131 442 1402 – to confirm the result after the match.

Match Fees and Expenses

Fees and expenses of the referee and assistant referees (where applicable) are settled by the home club.

Cup Competitions

All matches shall be played to a finish i.e. extra time and/or kicks from the penalty mark.

Pitch Inspections/Postponements

If the ground is unplayable the Home Club must inform their opponents, the referee and the League Secretary not later than 10am on the day of the match, or by 2pm for an evening match, or as agreed by both Clubs. As far as possible, a referee should make the decision about a pitch being playable or unplayable. A Club may only declare a pitch unplayable the day before the fixture date in the event of extreme weather conditions or on the grounds of the health and safety of the players, officials or spectators of both Clubs. The League Secretary may appoint a referee to carry out a pitch inspection. The cost of such an inspection to be divided equally between the two Clubs.

Notes for Clubs: -

Home Clubs should contact the referee at least four days prior to the match to confirm arrangements i.e. venue and kick-off time.
