### Cup Competitions

All matches shall be played to a finish. No extra-time is played. The winner of a drawn cup tie will be determined by the taking of kicks from the penalty mark in accordance with the rules laid down by the International FA Board.

### Pitch Inspections

If there is a doubt about a ground being playable, the home club must arrange, via the East Region General Secretary or Assistant Secretary, a ground inspection between 9.00 am and 10.00 am on the day of the match.

The referee appointed to the match is required to communicate any postponement to the Disciplinary and Referee Department.

Notes for Clubs: -

Home Clubs should contact the referee at least 48 hours prior to the match to confirm arrangements i.e. venue and kick-off time.

Any change to the appointment of the referee will be communicated to both clubs.
