Having previously confirmed your availability for appointment for these matches, you are not required to confirm your acceptance of the actual appointment. Should, however, it become necessary to withdraw from the appointment, contact should initially be made by telephone with the SFA Disciplinary and Referee Department and thereafter confirmed by letter or e-mail.

By accepting an appointment, any consent which may be necessary for the purposes of Part II of the Copyright, Designs and Patents Act for the recording or broadcasting by or on behalf of the Scottish Premier League of the relevant match(es) is given.

The referee must liaise with the Secretary of the ground club (who will be notified of any alteration(s) to the appointed officials) in regard to making travelling arrangements from an agreed rendezvous point to and from the ground. The referee is responsible for communicating this information to his team of officials.

The appropriate match fee and expenses will be paid by the Scottish Football Association on behalf of the Scottish Premier League. A match fee/expenses form should be submitted to the Disciplinary and Referee Department no later than three days after the match.

Please refer to the copy of the Extract from the Rules of the Scottish Premier League. Referees are requested to ensure that the requirements of Rule B18.2 – Match Report, are complied with.
